

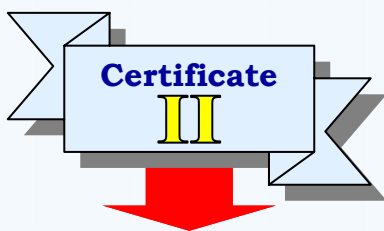
Extractive Industries Training Package

- To What Level do I Train to? -

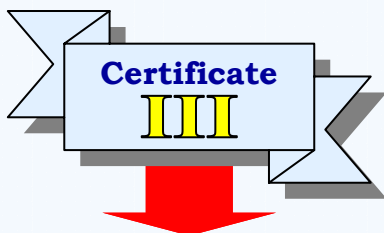
Every day, the CMPA receives calls from members asking us questions about the new Extractive Industries Training Package and how it affects them and their employees.

The diagram below is the first in a series of supporting documents with the aim of assisting all persons in the extractive industries to prepare for and participate in their professional development.

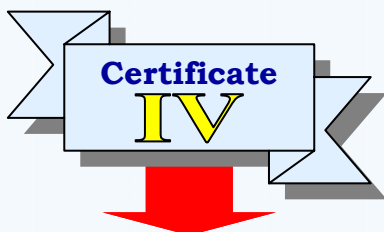

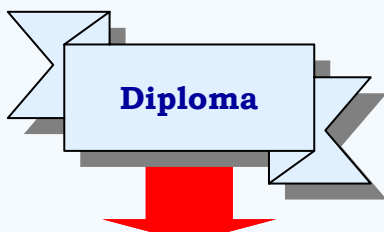
Applicable to: New employees being inducted into the industry and existing employees such as mobile and fixed plant, weighbridge, laboratory and other office personnel



Applicable to: Senior plant operators and shot firers, leading hands having substantial experience in the industry



Applicable to: Site Supervisors, Team Leaders and Managers of small quarries and provides the basis for individuals to design and implement processes that meet output and legislative requirements



Applicable to: Managers of large quarries or a number of smaller quarries and adds business management skills to technical management responsibilities



Applicable to: Senior Managers with responsibilities for a number of quarries
